**SCOUTING YEAR PARENTAL PERMISSION SLIP**

THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA PROGRAM INCLUDES MANY TYPES OF ACTIVITIES FOR SCOUTS. THESE INCLUDE TROOP AND PATROL MEETINGS, WEEKEND CAMPING TRIPS, DAY TRIPS, A WEEK IN SUMMER CAMP AND ANY OTHER RELATED PROGRAM ACTIVITY. MANY OF THESE ACTIVITIES INCLUDE SPORTS, RUNNING, HIKING, BACKPACKING, COOKING, CAMP FIRE BUILDING, WORKING WITH WOOD TOOLS, AND OTHER RELATED ACTIVITIES. WHILE TROOP 170 USES ALL REQUIRED METHODS OF SUPERVISION (TWO-DEEP LEADERSHIP, TRAINED LEADERS, SIGHT AND SOUND AT ALL TIMES), INSTRUCTION, PLANNING AND SAFETY METHODS, THERE IS STILL ALWAYS THE REMOTE POSSIBILITY OF ACIDENT OR INJURY AS WITH ANY ACTIVE PROGRAM. BECAUSE OF THIS, TROOP 170 REQUIRES EACH SCOUTS PARENT OR GUARDIAN TO SIGN THIS PERMISSION SLIP EACH YEAR IN ORDER FOR YOUR SCOUT TO TAKE PART IN OUR PROGRAM. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH PARENT OR GUARDIAN TO INFORM THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN AND/OR SCOUTMASTER OF ANY MEDICAL OR PHYSICAL PROBLEM A SCOUT HAS THAT MIGHT PRESENT A PROBLEM FOR SAFETY REASONS. IT IS EACH PARENT OR GUARDIAN'S RESPONSIBILTY TO STAY INFORMED OF TROOP EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES AND TO ENSURE THAT EACH OF THEIR SCOUTS HAS THE PROPER CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT FOR ANY ACTIVITY THAT THEIR SCOUT TAKES PART IN. IF THERE IS A QUESTION ON THIS MATTER THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN SHOULD CONTACT THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN OR SCOUT MASTER .
